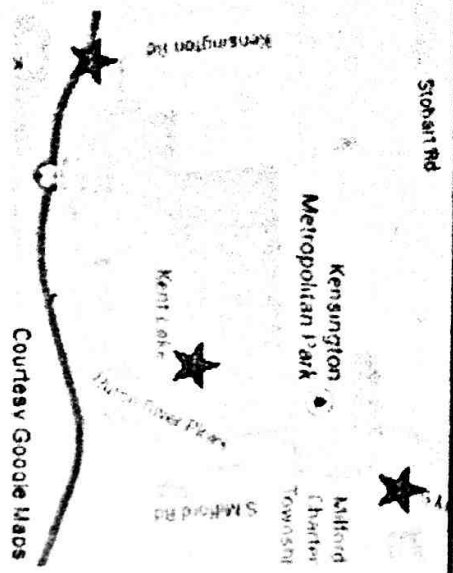


18th Annual Kensington Astronomy at the Beach

- Feel free to bring a flashlight with a red filter. A red balloon makes a quick and inexpensive filter!

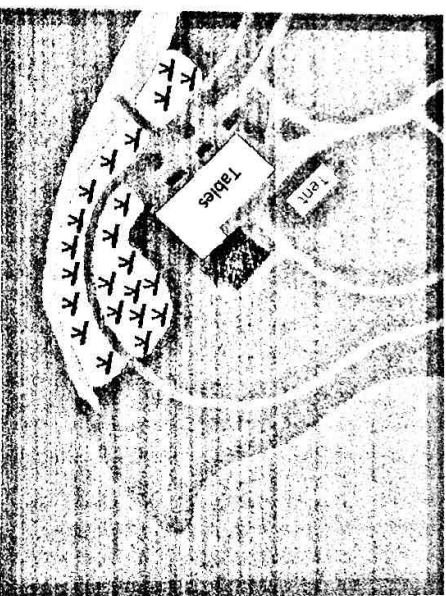
